- Hoopsters** • Grades K-1, Co-Ed league play

* Rosters for the recreational division are formed through a player placement workout process and all players will receive fair playing time; as close to half of each game, including playoffs, as feasible.

**** Open Divisions** – For boys & girls teams, grades 3-4, 5-6, 7-8. The Open Divisions will be further divided into Gold & Silver Divisions (based on skill level and experience) given sufficient number of teams registered. Full rostered teams may enter these divisions with the understanding that there is no guaranteed playing time for players.

Player Eligibility:

- Players may play on more than one team, but must be in a different division.
- Players may play in an older division; however, playing in their grade division cannot be more than one year older than their current grade.

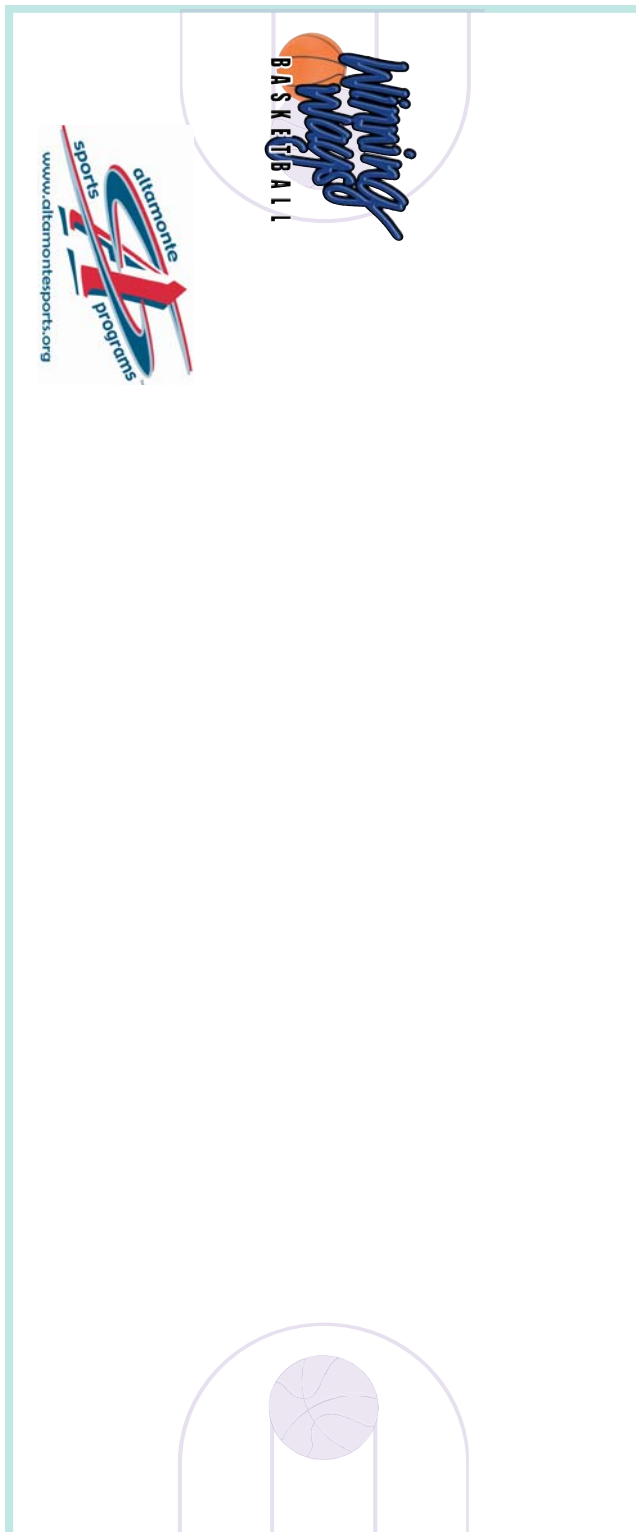
Winning Ways Basketball 2010-2011 YOUTH LEAGUES
