



Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Can my child be put on the same team as another child?** We can make note of the request on your registration form, but we can make no guarantees that they will be placed on the same team.
2. **Can my child request a specific coach?** Once again, we can make note of the request on your registration form, but we can make no guarantee that your child will be placed on that team.
3. **What if my child cannot make the night of player placement?** Your child will be placed on a team arbitrarily by the League Director once all players that were at the player placement have been placed on teams.
4. **What is player placement?** That is the night where all the players get assigned to a team. Players will come in, be given a number, and then run thru a mini tryout while the coaches watch. The coaches will then go into a draft to choose players until every child has been placed. Coaches will then call their players 7-10 days after the end of that week and inform the players of the teams' information.
5. **What do I do if I, my spouse, or someone I know would like to coach?** Make note of it on the child's registration form and then speak to Stormi or Megan.
6. **When and where will practices be held?** Practice dates will be determined by the coach, you will be informed of the specific date and time when the coach contacts you to inform you of your child's team.
7. **What if my child cannot practice on certain nights due to prior commitments?** Please make note of that on your registration form and we will do our best to make sure that your child will not be placed on a team that practices that night.

8. **When and where will games be played?** Games will be played on Saturdays for all divisions except Classic Division, which will play Thursday nights and/or Saturdays. Times and location will vary depending on the division. Hoopsters will always play at the Fieldhouse between 9am-1pm. Games for other divisions could be played at Brantley South or the Fieldhouse and times will vary.
9. **What is the difference between the Prep Division and Classic Division?** Prep Division is for 3rd-8th graders that register individually and are looking to be placed on a team. Classic Division is for 3rd-8th grade teams. Prep Division and Classic Division are two separate divisions; they do not play against each other at any time throughout the season. The Classic Division is a more competitive division in that usually those teams have been playing together for a while and play year round.
10. **Can my child register for both Prep and Classic Division?** Yes. If your child is already on a team that will be playing in the Classic Division, then he/she may also register for the Prep Division if they so choose. Please be aware that there is a possibility that even though the teams are in two separate divisions, both teams may be scheduled to play at the same time at two different locations. If that happens, your child will have to decide where to play that day.
11. **Do I have to pay all at once or can I make payments?** You can pay all at once or you can make payments. The payment structure would be as follows: A down payment of \$50 at the time of registration and 3 payments of \$25 a month. Your payments need to be set up to be paid with a credit card for automatic debit each month. Your fee must be paid in full by December 16, 2011 at 5:00pm.
